



Academic Advisory Policy - Faculty of Nursing

Purpose

To establish a structured academic advising system that supports nursing students in achieving their educational and professional goals, ensuring alignment with the faculty's mission and academic standards.

Objectives

- Provide personalized guidance to assist students in course selection, career planning, and overcoming academic challenges.
- Regularly assess student performance to identify areas needing improvement and implement timely interventions.
- Ensure students are aware of and can access available academic resources, workshops, and support services.

Advisor Responsibilities

- Meet with assigned students at least once per semester.
- Maintain accurate records of advising sessions.
- Provide up-to-date information on curriculum requirements and institutional policies.
- Refer students to appropriate support services when necessary.

Student Responsibilities

- Initiate and attend scheduled advising meetings.
- Prepare for sessions with relevant questions and academic plans.
- Actively engage in the advising process and follow through on agreed-upon actions.

Implementation

- Assign each nursing student an academic advisor upon enrollment.
- Conduct orientation sessions to familiarize students with the advising system.
- Regularly evaluate the effectiveness of the advising program and make necessary adjustments.

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
