### 1. Objectives of the Assessment Policy

- Ensure fairness and transparency.

- Use assessment results to improve curriculum and teaching methods.

### 2. Types of Assessment

- Formative Assessment: Includes quizzes, assignments, and ongoing observations during the semester.
- Summative Assessment: Includes final exams, projects, and clinical evaluations.

### 3. Assessment Criteria

- Clarity: Clearly defined and communicated evaluation criteria for students.
- Consistency: Apply criteria uniformly across all courses.

### 4. Appeals Process

- Submission: Students may submit a written appeal within a specified period after results are announced.
- Review: An independent committee will review the appeal and make the appropriate decision.

### 5. Policy Development

- Periodic Review: Regularly update the assessment policy based on feedback.
- Training: Provide workshops for faculty on best assessment practices.

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
